Arid Gujarat

- 1. Farmers are advised to undertake irrigations for wheat at critical stages namely: jointing and booting stage, and second top dressing of N at booting stage or 50 days after sowing.
- 2. Farmers are advised to undertake irrigation and precautionary spray of Dimicron-100 (250ml)/Nuvacron (850ml) using 100 lit. water per hectare for aphid in mustard
- 3. Farmer should harvest mature castor capsules to avoid shattering problem.
- 4. The precautionary spray/dusting of sulphar should be done in cumin, when weather is cloudy.
- 5. Farmers are advised to start preparation of fields for summer groundnut in the region.
- 6. Now ber is on harvesting stage, it is advised to harvest the fruits at proper stage.
