Arid Gujarat

- Farmers are advised to harvest fruit crops before onset of rain for maintaining good quality of produce.
- Summer deep ploughing may be undertaken to expose the soil pests and for improving the water holding capacity of the soil.
- Farmers are advised to avoid application of irrigation in pruned ber orchard till onset of monsoon.
- Field preparation may be started for sowing of cotton, groundnut, clusterbean and sesame crops.
