Arid Gujarat

- 1. Farmers of the region are advised to apply irrigation in wheat crop at milking and dough stage.
- 2. Sulphar dust & karathane are advised as precautionary measure to prevent the possible attack of powdery mildew in cumin crop.
- 3. To avoid the seed shattering problem in mustard crop, farmers are advised for harvesting at proper stage.
- 4. Farmers are advised to take the sowing of summer groundnut, whenever night minimum temperature goes above 18⁰ C.
- 5. Regular irrigations are advised in date palm after initiation of inflorescence to avoid soil moisture stress.
- 6. Pomegranate is now in fruiting stage, so regular irrigations are advised to avoid soil moisture stress and fruit cracking problem in pomegranate.
