She deliberated about the need for upliftment of women in science and also elaborately told about the steps being taken worldwide to support and ensure the participation of women in the field of IP, trademarks and copyrights. Earlier, Dr. A. K Patel, Director Incharge CAZRI as well as Incharge ABI and ITMU welcomed the guest speaker and told about the need and importance of today's event.
