

Farmer's training on good agricultural practices in rabi crops

Farmer training on “Good Agricultural Practices in rabi crops” was organized on 8-9 February 2024 at ICAR-CAZRI-RRS, Jaisalmer under the SCSP programme. A total of 165 including farmers and farmwomen of village Kuchhri and Masudi of Jaisalmer district, participated in this programme. Dr R.S.Mehta advised farmers to adopt good agricultural practices in cumin, isabgol and chickpea for getting quality production. Dr. Anil Patidar explained about the seed multiplication techniques and their importance. Dr. S. C. Meena demonstrated the sticky and pheromone traps installation and explained their utilization in pest management. Dr. Saranya R. detailed about the diseases of cumin and chickpea crop, their diagnosis and management practices. Finally, Dr. Dileep Kumar gave detailed information of technologies developed by CAZRI in cumin crop. Afterward farmers visited nursery and field. At the end of training improved agricultural implements like battery operated sprayer, storage grain bin and improved were given to farmers.
