

Training on “Improved rabi production technologies and pomegranate cultivation” at Padasala village (Jodhpur)

An off-campus training on ‘Improved rabi production technologies and pomegranate cultivation’ was organized on 25th October 2018 at Padasala village- tehsil Bapini (Distt. Jodhpur) Thirty farmers participated in the training. During the training various aspects of organic farming such as development of nutrient rich compost, role of animals, agro-forestry trees, beneficial insects and birds, preparation of organic manure and disease management were discussed in detail. Beside these, farmers also took interest in arid horticultural crops such as ber, gonda and pomegranate. Management of pomegranate orchards such as pruning, pest and disease management and non-bearing of fruits in date palm were also addressed. Experiences of Integrated Farming System models at farmers’ field in Utambar village were also shared. Field visits were made to the farms of Sh. Tulsaram Sinwar (Pomegranate), Sh. Lalaram Dudi (groundnut, carrot and chilly) and Sh. Surjaram Godara (pomegranate and cotton).
