

Training on Improved Agronomic Practices for *Kharif* Crops organized under SCSP by ICAR-CAZRI-RRS, Jaisalmer

A training program under SCSP was organised at ICAR-CAZRI, RRS Jaisalmer on 26.10.2020. Twenty-five farmers of Basanpeer village participated in the program.
