

In-house Training of technician staffs on “Enhancing efficiency and behavioural skills” during 9-13 September, 2024

The inaugural session of a one-week training program on “Enhancing efficiency and behavioural skills” for Technicians (T-1) scheduled during September 09-13, 2024 was held on September 09, 2024, in the Conference Hall of the ICAR-Central Arid Zone Research Institute, Jodhpur. The training is organized by Human Resource Development and Higher Education Unit (HRD & HE) of the institute. The objective of the training is to enhance the technical competencies and improve behavioural skills of newly joined technicians staff of the institute for better data handling in the lab as well as field and management of field experiments. A total of 27 technicians from the Institute attended the training programme.
