## Hon'ble Vice President, Sh. Jagdeep Dhankhar interacted with farmers and scientists at ICAR-Central Arid Zone Research Institute, Jodhpur

Hon'ble Vice President of India, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar interacted with farmers and scientists in 'Farmers-Scientist Interaction' event organized at CAZRI Jodhpur on 7<sup>th</sup> October. He called upon farmers to adopt the business model for their produces for better livelihood.
